Dear Resident / Business

You may recall during April 2015 the Council asked your views on a proposal for a Controlled parking Zone (CPZ) option to be included as part of the previously agreed waiting restrictions. The outcome was residents of the area overwhelmingly rejected the CPZ option.

This leaflet is to advise you of the Council's intention to introduce waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) on one side of each road within the area except for Amberley Way, Wentworth Close and the Cul De Sac end of Rutland Drive (please see attach plan) which would have double yellow lines on both sides of the roads.

The Council carries out careful consultation to ensure that all road users are given a fair opportunity to give their views and express their needs on the proposed parking restrictions. The parking needs of the residents and visitors are given consideration however it is considered that maintaining safe access must take priority.

The proposed waiting restrictions will improve safety, visibility and provide clear access for all road users' particularly emergency services (fire brigade), vulnerable road users such as pedestrians, push chairs and wheelchair users. The proposed restrictions will also ensure that congestion is minimised and access to assist the flow of traffic is improved.

PROPOSED MEASURES

It is proposed to implement double yellow line waiting restrictions which will operate at all times, in the following roads:

- Amberley Way
- Claymore Close
- Hartland Way
- Litchfield Avenue
- Rustington Walk

- Rutland Drive
- Wentworth Close
- On both sides of all junctions

The proposed measures are shown on the plan overleaf and can also be viewed online at www.merton.gov.uk/wr-rutland.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A Notice of the Council's intentions to make the relevant Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) for the required changes will be published in the local newspaper (The Guardian), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations for and against the proposals must be done in writing to Future Merton (Traffic and Highway Team 13th Floor), Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX or email trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk by no later than **12 February 2016** quoting reference **ES/ RUTLAND DRIVE AREA**

Objections must relate only to the elements of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation. The Council is required to give weight to the nature and content of your representations and not necessarily the quantity. Your reasons are therefore important to us.

Copies of the proposed Traffic Management Order (TMO), a plan identifying the area affected by the proposal and the Council's 'Statement of Reasons' can be inspected at the Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, during the Council's normal office hours Mondays to Fridays, 9am to 5pm.

All representations along with Officers' comments and recommendations will be presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Environmental Sustainability and Regeneration. Please note that responses to any

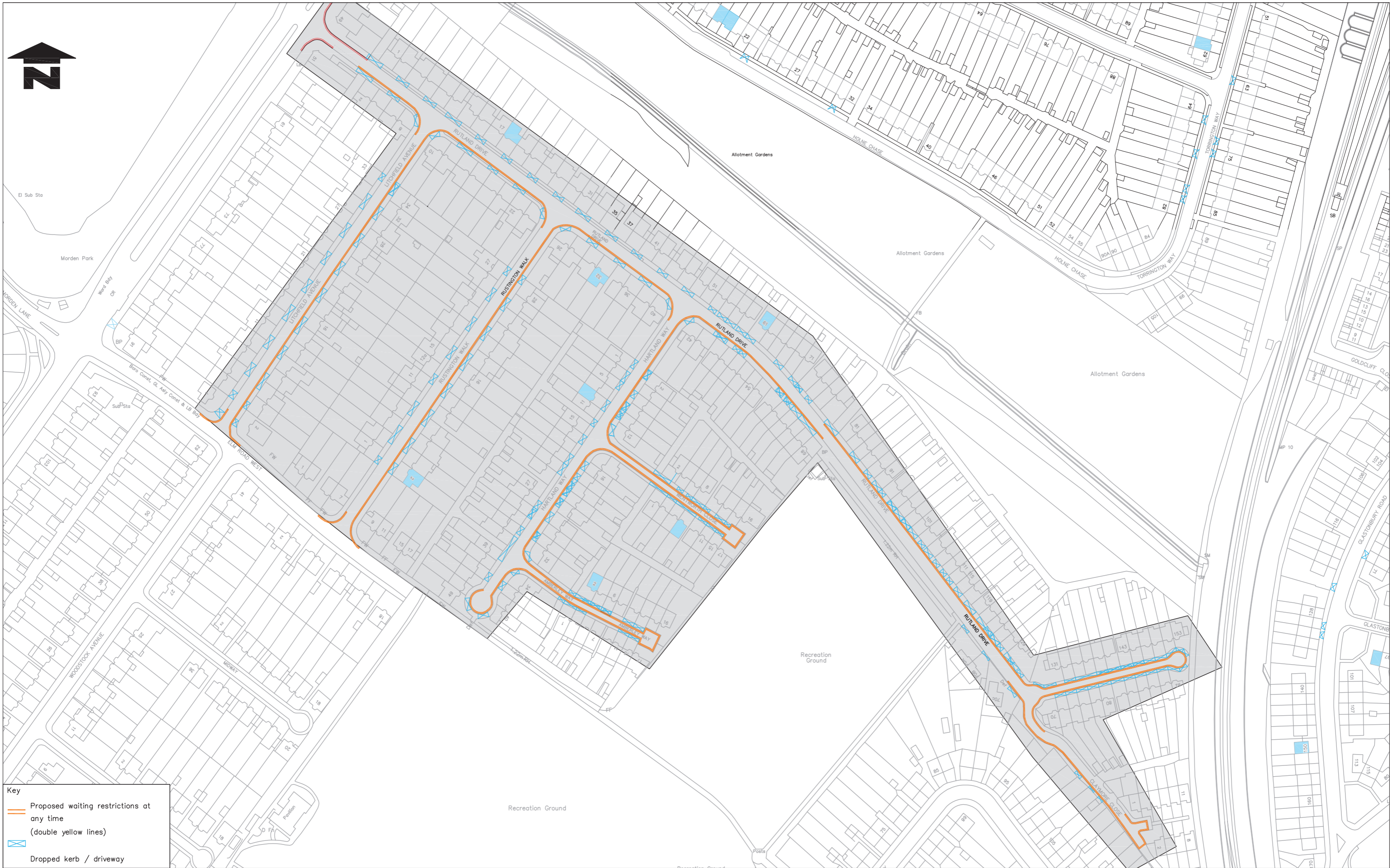
