The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that all the feedback received to the statutory consultation that was carried out between 18th July and 16th August 2024 to introduce speed humps along Friday Road and Crusoe Road, have been considered and a final decision has been made to proceed with the implementation of the proposed measures.

## Date and Time of Works

The works will be carried out between **27**<sup>th</sup> **January and 7**<sup>th</sup> **February 2025**, weather permitting, and every effort will be made to minimise any inconvenience the works may cause. Notice boards will be placed in advance of the works, advising all road users of these specific dates. The construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm. FM Conway Ltd will carry out the works on behalf of the Council.

## Traffic Management and Access Arrangements

To allow the works to be carried out as swiftly as possible, temporary parking restrictions will be introduced when and where necessary. "No Parking" cones and signs will be in place to indicate the areas where parking would be prohibited. By doing so, this will keep the roads free of parked vehicles allowing a smooth transition for the works. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible removal. Notices and cones will be placed in your road 12-48 hours prior to work being undertaken.

Road closures will be in place at the location of each individual road hump being constructed and works will only be carried out one road hump at a time to ensure access to all properties is maintained at all times via short diversions routes where required.
