Change of hours update

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that following the completion of the statutory consultation carried out between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to change the hours of operation for the school street, a decision has been made to change the existing hours to:

**8.15 – 9.15 am & 2.45 – 4.00 pm**  
**It will operate Monday – Friday term times only.**

The Council will be making the Traffic Management Order to reflect this change.  
The new restrictions will come into effect at the start of the school's new term in September 2022.

The hours on all the signs will be changed prior to September 2022.

The Council intended to change the advisory signs to pictorial signs. However, due to lack of funding, this will not take place at this time.
