ST MARK'S PRIMARY SCHOOL STREETS - PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE PROPOSED CHANGES TO OPERATIONAL TIMES

THE MERTON (PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE) (ST MARK'S PRIMARY SCHOOL) (NO. *) TRAFFIC ORDER 202*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to:-
 - (a revoke The Merton (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (St Mark's Primary School) Traffic Order 2022; and
 - (b) re-introduce its provisions so as to prohibit all motorised vehicles from entering the roads or lengths of road listed in column 3 of the Schedule to this notice, during the new proposed corresponding periods specified, with certain exemptions, including for those authorised vehicles which are specified on a white list for those roads or lengths of road held and maintained by the Council.
 - N.B. Enforcement is carried out school term-times only.
- 3. A copy of the proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including a plan which indicates the roads or lengths of road to which the Order relates, can be inspected Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden. - 4.
