Dear Resident / Business,

A statutory consultation was carried out in October 2023 for various improvements along Streatham Road under TfL's Healthy Streets and Vision Zero programme. All representations and other feedback were considered and presented to the Cabinet Member for a decision, and it has been agreed to proceed with the implementation of Phase 1. This covers the section between Graham Road and Sandy Lane, as shown on the plan overleaf.

### Date and Time of Works

The works will be carried out in multiple stages commencing **27<sup>th</sup> August** until **20<sup>th</sup> December 2024**, weather permitting. Every effort will be made to reduce this time where possible. Notice boards will be placed on street in advance of the works, advising all road users of these specific dates.

Most of the construction work will take place between the hours of **8am and 5pm, Monday to Friday**. Works on the highway will be carried out by FM Conway Ltd.

### Traffic Management and Access Arrangements

There will be temporary road closures in some of the side roads with diversions for the duration of the works. Some evening closures to Streatham Rd for the final carriageway re-surfacing will also apply. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Parking restrictions / suspensions on the public highway will be introduced where necessary to facilitate equipment and materials storage. "No Parking" cones and signs will be in place to indicate where and when parking would be prohibited. It should be noted that whilst the restrictions are in place, illegally parked vehicles will be removed.
