* Collections will change over the Christmas and New Year period and may take place up to three days later than usual. This calendar shows your revised collection days where appropriate.

 * Real Christmas tree collections start on 6th January. Put your tree out from Monday 6th January and it will be collected as soon as possible.

It really helps if you...

Flatten cardboard boxes before putting them in the blue lidded wheelie bin

Empty and rinse all containers before putting them in the green box

Remove film lids from plastic pots, tubs and trays (put the film lids in your black wheelie bin)

Only place items that cannot be recycled in your **black wheelie bin** - no food waste please

On collection day, place your bins at the **front edge of your property**, close to the pavement but not on it

Household batteries are collected every week. Leave them on top of your recycling in an untied bag. Visit: slwp.org.uk/recyclables/household-batteries.uk for more information.
